Wapahani Alumni Scholarship Guidelines

The Liberty-Perry Alumni Association (LPAA) has established the Wapahani Alumni Scholarship to be presented to a graduating Wapahani High School senior. The applicant must be accepted to an accredited college or university located within the United States. Applicant must plan to pursue a four-year degree of his/her choosing.

One non-renewable scholarship of \$750 will be awarded to a college or university bound student who most demonstrates a desire to succeed in their chosen career, a willingness to work toward goals, has a positive attitude, and shows pride in being a Wapahani Raider. In addition, careful consideration will be given to the applicant's academic achievements and ability, citizenship and moral character, honors and awards received, extra-curricular activities, community service activities, financial need, and answers to essay questions included in the application form.

Applications will be evaluated by LPAA Board Members, based on the following guidelines:

- Must have a GPA of 2.5 or higher. (copy of high school grades transcript required)
- Applicant **must have** a parent, grandparent who graduated from Wapahani High School.
- Must demonstrate school spirit and pride in being a Wapahani Raider.
- Must provide proof of enrollment (**Acceptance Letter**) in an accredited state or community college/university
- Must provide two letters of reference: One reference letter from a Liberty-Perry teacher and one reference letter from a community member not related to the student and **not a teacher/coach**.
- Must provide with your completed application PDF, a recent photograph of yourself.
- **Applications that are not complete will not be accepted.**
- Please email your completed PDF application, grades transcript, two letters of reference, proof of enrollment and your picture, to the designated person listed below.

Winning applicant will receive a personalized 4" x 8" Engraved Brick to be placed into the 2nd Brick Walkway in the front lawn around the flagpole of Wapahani High School.

The LPAA Wapahani Alumni Scholarship winning recipient will be officially announced both at the Awards Day in May 2026 at Wapahani High School and at the Wapahani High School graduation ceremony in June 2026. Scholarship money will be directly sent to the Financial Aid department of the college or university chosen by applicant. Student I.D. number and pertinent corresponding information will be needed for the LPAA to transfer scholarship funds to student's college account.
