Description of Laycie Marie Chambers

Laycie Marie Chambers was born in Winchester, IN on August 29, 2006 and was a Sophomore at Wapahani High School. Laycie was a member of the girls wrestling team and played bass clarinet in the school band. Laycie loved all things horses, including her beloved Sadie. She was also a long-time member of 4-H, showing pigs and rabbits. Laycie was involved in a motor vehicle accident in mid-January 2023. Unfortunately, Laycie passed away at Riley Children's Hospital on Thursday, January 19, 2023, from injuries sustained in the accident, at the tender age of 16. Laycie would have graduated from Wapahani High School in 2025. Laycie had a deep compassion for animals of all kinds. She was very grateful to others and had a passion for Bull Riding.

Description of Laycie Marie Chambers Memorial Scholarship

The 2025/2026 LCAA Laycie Marie Chambers Memorial Scholarship was created by the Liberty-Perry Alumni Association (LCAA) to pay tribute and honor Laycie Marie Chambers. The non-renewable, one-time scholarships will be valued at \$1,800 each and will be given to Wapahani seniors at the discretion of the LCAA. There were two scholarships given in 2025 and an additional two scholarships to be given in 2026, totaling four. The LCAA will choose applicants who demonstrate in their application, a desire to learn, good moral character and willingness to help others. In addition, careful consideration will be given to the applicant's academic achievement, leadership skills, extracurricular activities, community/volunteer activities, letters of recommendation and answers to the essay questions.

The applicant(s) must be accepted to an accredited college or university located within the United States. Applicant(s) must plan to pursue a four-year degree of his/her choosing. **Each winning applicant will receive a personalized 4" x 8" Engraved Brick to be placed into the 2nd Brick Walkway in the front lawn around the flagpole of Wapahani High School.**

Applications will be evaluated by LPAA Board Members, based on the following guidelines:

- Must have a GPA of 2.5 or higher. (copy of high school grades transcript required)
- Tell how you knew Laycie Marie Chambers, if applicable
- Must provide proof of enrollment (**Acceptance Letter**) in an accredited state or community college/university
- Must provide two letters of reference: One reference letter from a Liberty-Perry teacher and one reference letter from a community member not related to the student and **not a teacher/coach.**
- Must provide with your completed application PDF, a recent photograph of yourself.
- **Applications that are not complete will not be accepted.**
- Please email your completed PDF application, grades transcript, two letters of reference, proof of enrollment and your picture, to the designated person listed below.

The LPAA 2026 Laycie Marie Chambers Memorial Scholarship winning recipient(s) will be officially announced both at the Awards Day in May 2026 at Wapahani High School and at the Wapahani High School graduation ceremonies in June 2026. Scholarship money will be directly sent to the Financial Aid department of the college or university chosen by applicant. Student I.D. number and pertinent corresponding information will be needed for the LPAA to transfer scholarship funds to student's college account.
